# **Sunshine Coast Friendship Tournament – Important Information**

Sunday, 5th August 2012 @ Millwell Rd Community Centre, Maroochydore

**TEAM KATA compulsory for all entries:** In order to enter the friendship tournament you must enter a team in the team kata event. The purpose of this is to encourage you to get to know and work closely with other members from your dojo that you may not normally work with and in the process developing stronger friendships within the dojo.

**Random kata selection:** Unlike normal kata competitions, participants will not be able to practice only 1 or 2 kata in preparation for the tournament. Your kata will be selected at random for you immediately before your performance from the shitei kata list on the reverse side of this page based on your current level. In order to do well, you must practice all of the kata listed on your shitei kata list for your level and be prepared to do anything. In addition, this competition format will help to level the playing field a little bit more with an element of luck. Just like you, your competitors may not get the opportunity to perform their favourite kata.

#### **Individual Kata**

There will be 3 divisions for individual kata.

- **<u>BEGINNER</u>** White-Green Belt & Little Champions
- <u>INTERMEDIATE</u> Blue-Purple Belt
- <u>ADVANCED</u> Brown-Black Belt

**<u>Kata Selection</u>**: Unlike a normal tournament, you will not find out which kata you are performing until you step into the ring ready to perform. At that time the head referee will select a kata at random from the list on the reverse side of this page (appropriate to your rank & division).

Please note, members of the Queensland Team may have some additional kata or different kata which may be selected. The purpose of this is to help these competitors by giving them the opportunity to perform under pressure with more advanced kata in preparation for the national championships

#### Team Kata

There will be 2 divisions for team kata.

- QLD Team Members This event is open only to people who are on the QLD Team and will be entered in team kata for the nationals. These members may only compete in this division.
- Open Division This event is open to all ages and levels. Teams <u>may</u> only include 1 member who is blue belt or higher.

**<u>Kata Selection</u>**: Kata will be selected at random from the shitei kata lists on the reverse side of this page (based on the lowest ranked team member).

**<u>Kata Selection Example:</u>** For a team consisting of a purple belt, a yellow belt and a white belt member, possible kata selections could be: kihon dosa ichi, kihon dosa ni, or seiken no migi hidari.



#### Kumite Tag & Kumite

Kumite Tag will be open to all Little Champions & competitors ranked White-Green Belt only. Kumite will be open to competitors of any rank. Competitors may only compete in either Kumite Tag OR Kumite, NOT BOTH. There will be various divisions based on age and gender as per the entry form.
